The motor cycle group, are going to receive some training on keeping financial record, profit and loss. Making a business plan so they can apply for loans and we have been discussing micro finance.

The youth who have been involved with drugs need alternatives to their former lifestyle and activities to help them abstain from drugs. Maybe, a short course in life skills and making good choices.

The youth group 10-15 years have been learning about "human rights" and how this applies to their life. We will also be involving the in some fun outdoor activities.

The young girls group has been mainly listening to their stories and counseling them, they need to build their confidence and start moving forward in their life, with the right support and guidance to make good choices for the future. We have also been informing them of their rights so they know to stand up if someone is doing them wrong in the future.
